Picatrix is the name used today, for a page book of magic and astrology originally written in Arabic under the title *Kitab Ghayat al-Akram*, which most scholars assume was originally written in the middle of the 11th century, though an argument for composition in the first half of the 12th century was produced sometime later, based on translation of the Latin version.

Together these two volumes contain all four books of the Complete Picatrix. According to this document<sup>1</sup> the original Arabic name of the book was *Al Azif*. The Liber Atratus edition adds a passage on poisons from Ibn Washiyya's *Ask Saturn in petitions concerning old people or generous men, senators* [2 12].
